This letter is a written notification that as of today (March 12th, 2021) our Lauderdale Lakes Law Enforcement Patrol has received notice from the WI Dept. of Natural Resources that All Boating Safety Course Offerings are NOT able to be held due to the ongoing Pandemic and Safety Protocols surrounding COVID-19. This decision has been made in the interest of protecting Instructors, Parents, and Students enrolled in these classes. This letter serves as notice to our Lake Community members due to the Health Situation ongoing in Wisconsin and around the Country.
