5. Resolution 2025-02 Recreational Boating Facility (RBF) Grant Application:
Refurbishment of Weed Harvesting Equipment.

- A special meeting was called to approve a resolution for refurbishing the 1991 weed harvester.
- The state is offering grants covering 50% of the refurbishment cost, with a submission deadline of November 1st.
- Aquarius, the manufacturer, is familiar with the grant program and is working with other lake districts to submit similar grant applications.
- The grant application is through the Wisconsin Waterways Commission that oversees the Recreational Boating Facilities (RBF) Program, which provides funding for projects like weed harvesting equipment refurbishment.
- The board needs to approve the project, authorize the grant application submission and assign a project lead.

- The resolution requests financial assistance for refurbishing the ~~wheat~~ weed harvesting equipment.
- The Lake District has a budget sufficient to complete the project.
- The resolution authorizes a board member (Ken Partyka) to:
 - Submit an application to the Wisconsin Waterways Commission for financial assistance.
 - Sign documents related to the project.
 - Take necessary action to undertake and complete the approved project.
- The Lauderdale Lakes Lake Management District will comply with state and federal rules, maintain the project, and obtain written approval for any changes.
- The resolution needs to be signed and is one of six items required for the grant application.
- Other documents, including the approved Aquatic Plant Management (APM) plan, are also required for submission.
- They are on track for the November 1st deadline.
