



- Attendance not taken, 8 people in attendance, largely represented by the Lauderdale Lake Improvement Association (LLIA)
- ➤ Kickoff meeting presentation (7 slides) by Brian Valleskey of Geosyntec
- Open Discussion (from slide review and open dialogue)
