The proposed budget was unanimously approved by the Board on a Summers/ Bostrom motion. The proposed budget for 2022 is \$377,000. This equates to a tax levy of \$247,169. It is also proposed to add \$30,000 to the tax levy for continued golf course improvements and equipment.

The proposed 2022 tax levy will be \$277,169.
